- 1- Take into account the requirements of the University of Sapienza:
 - An intermediate level of Italian language, B2 is mandatory for students wishing to follow courses in Italian.
 - An intermediate level of English language, B2 is mandatory for students wishing to follow courses in English.
- 2- Students and teachers pre-selected by the home university will receive from Sapienza an access code to the online registration platform.

The platform will be active for 8 days: students and staff will have 8 days from the receipt of Sapienza's email to fill in the online application form.
